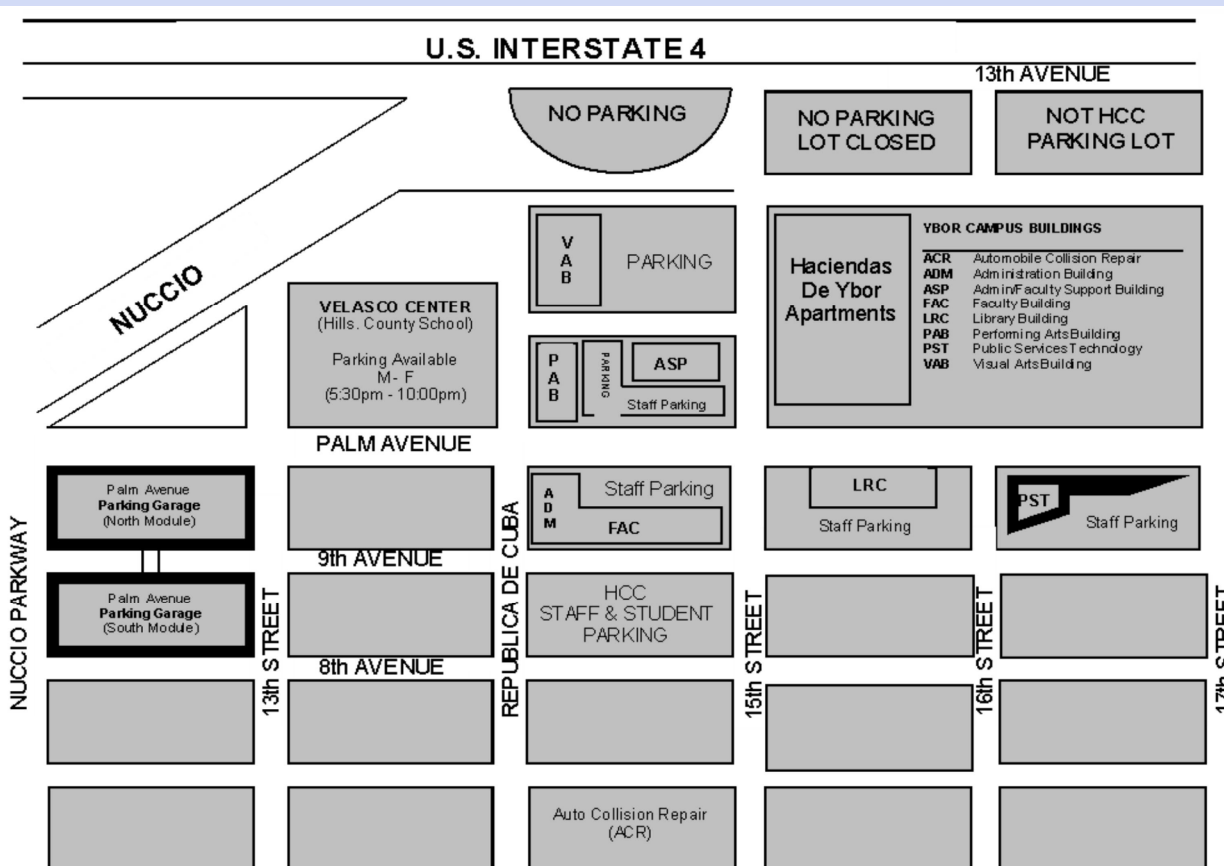

OC Aerosol Projector Instructor Certification

This Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC) Course is eight (8) hours in length and is approved for mandatory retraining only.

This comprehensive instructor's course focuses on the proper deployment and safe use of chemical devices and alternatives featuring the Defense Technology/Federal Laboratories product line. All students successfully completing this course will receive factory authorized dual instructor certification from Defense Technology/Federal laboratories, enabling them to provide departmental in-service training. Additionally, students will be provided with the information necessary to develop lesson plans, draft policy and procedures, and provide valid documentation supporting the use of chemical munitions. Morning classroom instruction is reinforced with practical range application in the afternoon. Ample chemical munitions & comprehensive materials are provided for each student.

Mandatory Equipment Requirements for Students

Assigned duty gear to include baton w/ holder
Handcuffs with key and case
Towel
Change of clothing
Uniform normally worn when deploying chemical munitions

Upon successful completion, Defense Technology will certify the student as an instructor in the appropriate subject. Each attendee must be physically fit for duty and able to perform the physical skills associated with tactical applications with the use of these products.
